### Make God Smile!

*"Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children; and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma." Ephesians 5:1-2*

Over the past few weeks, something exciting happened! Grant gained the ability to smile at things he enjoys (for example, a toy) or finds a little funny (for example, me). Yes, Noelani and I are still smitten with our little blessing. Please bear with me while I share some thoughts about this latest development in baby land. When our son smiles back at us in imitation of the smiling faces we're making at him, we get so excited! I think it's the same way with God. When we imitate Him, He smiles. It's what He wants, and He's so excited that we're His children!

How do we imitate God? By walking in love, and by giving ourselves up as a sacrifice (Rom. 12:1) Those are great words, but what do they look like in reality? Service. When we do something for someone else's sake, we are imitating Christ. When we go outside our comfort zone, go the extra mile, or sacrifice part of our wants for someone else, we are imitating Christ's life of service. How far can we take this idea? All the way to the end of our life.

A sacrifice of your time and effort can help with that.
